# MFA (Master of Fine Art)

#### Two years, full-time

#### Open to

Those with relevant work experience in the arts, an honours degree or equivalent qualification in Fine Art or a related discipline.

#### **MFA**

The MFA is designed to further advance students' in practical, theoretical and professional domains, with an emphasis on specialist studio practice.

#### MFA Blended delivery

The same as our MFA but with greater flexibility to study around your existing commitments. Students attend a series of ten one-week, on-site study blocks, in combination with access to online resources.

#### MFA Craft Practices

Our MFA Craft Practices focuses on making techniques, materials, and processes. It combines the skills and knowledge of traditional crafts with contemporary design principles and artistic expression.

Our BA in Art and Contemporary Craft is an innovative programme built around the needs of creators; for those who are ambitious about developing their studio practice, want to maintain a sustained engagement with an artistic community but whose life and work demands flexibility. You will study at the intersection of fine art and contemporary craft, exploring interdisciplinary approaches in intensive blocks that are scheduled to suit you.

# **TAPESTRY WEAVING**

#### Two year, part-time

Aimed at tapestry weavers who have completed a beginners' course at West Dean or elsewhere.

#### **About**

This course offers a broad insight into the technical and creative techniques of weaving, necessary for developing skills and building your own creative language. Each unit will be based in the unique environment of West Dean Tapestry Studio, one of the UK's only professional tapestry studios specialising in contemporary design and weaving using traditional techniques.

# **CERAMICS**

## Two year, part-time

## Open to

Suitable for potters who have had some experience working with clay, and are looking to develop confidence.

#### **About**

This programme offers a comprehensive understanding of the material as well as teaching you a variety of clay techniques from hand-building to throwing, decorating and glazing work. Develop your skills and build up your own creative language whilst being supported to create work based around your own research and interests.

#### LOCATION

The West Dean campus is based between Chichester and Midhurst, in the beautiful South Downs. Less than half an hour from beaches and coastline. there is also easy access to London and Brighton. Chichester and Midhurst are known for their thriving arts scene with independent shops, cafes and restaurants.
