Edward James Foundation Bursaries

Candidates who have accepted their place on a Diploma or Degree Programme and paid their deposit can apply for a bursary from the Edward James Foundation Bursary. The Foundation grants bursaries to students who have a financial need. Bursaries will be awarded towards a portion of tuition fees, and not usually for accommodation fees or living expenses. Please note if a bursary is awarded, it will not cover the full tuition fees. Bursaries are awarded at the discretion of the Foundation's Grants Committee. Scholarships

Outstanding students or students with great potential may also be eligible to apply for a scholarship award.
