

George Daniels Educational Trust Horology Bursary application form for Clocks related Diploma or Degree Programmes 2026-27.

Deadline for applications 1 April 2026

Candidates who have accepted their place to study on a Clocks related Diploma or Degree programme can apply for a George Daniels Educational Trust Horology Bursary through West Dean (part of the Edward James Foundation Limited). Bursaries are awarded at the discretion of the Foundation's Grants Committee and the George Daniels Educational Trust. How to complete this form

- Tick the bursary you are applying for

- Include a detailed financial plan. The financial plan should be in addition to the income and expenditure section of this application form. Applications for a George Daniels Educational Trust Horology Bursary will not be considered without a financial plan.

Applications are considered by the Foundation's Grants Committee and details of the successful nominees such as name, nationality, programme, personal statement, and references will be sent to the George Daniels Educational Trust for the final decision. Applicants should note that students will be required to sign terms and conditions if awarded a grant.

Deadline and application submission for bursaries

Please note unsuccessful applicants are unable to request feedback from the Grants Committee.

Please include two typed references, one of which should be from a current or recent tutor and should address why you are the best candidate for the bursary you are applying for. Your application will not be considered if the two references are not included or if your application is incomplete.

Current students do not have to include references, but a tutor reference will be requested if nominated for a bursary.

	To help those students who, through lack of access to the necessary funds, might not feel able to pursue their dream of studying a clocks related degree or diploma at West Dean, the Trust is providing funding for a limited number of students to help with their fees or living expenses.		
	Criteria: The George Daniels Educational Trust Horology Bursary will be awarded to students applying to study on or progressing their study to one of the following programmes: Foundation Degree Arts (FdA) - Clocks; BA (Hons) Craft Practices - Clocks*; MFA Craft Practices - Clocks; Graduate Diploma Horology, Clocks and Related Objects; MA Conservation Studies - Horology, Clocks and Related Objects.		
	The Trust expects applicants to demonstrate a strong connection with Britain, and on this basis, preference will be given to individuals holding British Citizenship who have been mainly educated within the British Islands.		



Students must demonstrate outstanding potential; a commitment to their studies; demonstrate a clear aim for career development; demonstrate financial hardship such as finding it difficult to find the funds for fees or living expenses**

Application: The Grants Committee will consider the applications and details of the successful nominees such as name, nationality, programme, personal statement, and references will be sent to the Trust for the final decision.

Terms: Successful recipients on courses lasting more than one year are expected to reapply for funding in subsequent years of that course. Any awards made in successive years of the course would be subject to making a new bursary application, demonstration of satisfactory academic performance and confirmation that the students financial circumstances remain virtually unchanged from the date of the previously approved funding application. The award will be paid directly to West Dean.

Please note students who have applied for a George Daniels Educational Trust Horology
Accommodation Bursary towards on campus accommodation are also eligible to apply for the George Daniels Educational Trust Horology
Bursary, however they must demonstrate financial hardship, such that without the two bursaries the opportunity to study at West Dean would not be possible.
